

SHIPBOARD ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICER

The shipboard environmental officer is the role model responsible for ensuring compliance with the safety and environmental management system and promoting safety and environmental protection culture on board

- ISM Code pollution prevention requirements and workplace environment
- Duties and responsibilities of the shipboard environmental officer
- MARPOL - environmental regulatory framework
- Record keeping, hazard identification, and assessment of risks
- Reporting requirements, operational issues, and environmental inspections
- Environmental protection culture on board and training requirements
- Practical exercises and case studies
