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PERFORMING COMPETENCY ASSESSMENTS FOR VERIFICATION OF SEAFARER BEHAVIORAL SKILLS

Course aim and objectives: Behavioral Competency is an approach to safety which focuses on seafarers' on-the-job behavioral performance gaps in the course of ship operations. This is one of the main contributing factors, to most work-related injuries and accidents. Moreover, "at risk" behaviors are the least measurable and observable events before workplace injuries take place. Participants will have the opportunity to develop new skills through strategies on how to assess seafarer Behavioral Competencies with a view to motivate seafarer improved performance and at work safer behavior by implementing comprehensive behavioral competency assurance program(s). The course conforms to industry best practice guidance including OCIMF's SIRE 2.0, TMSA, RISQ, DRY-BMS and SIGTTO relevant recommendations and applies to all types of vessels under various operational patterns with focus on assessing seafarer behavioral competencies during navigation, cargo, mooring and engineering operations. The course also focuses on the skills required for individuals to perform competency assessments in contrast with those qualified to conduct management system audits
