

TANKER SHIP VETTING INSPECTIONS

SIRE 2.0

Course aim and objectives: The course provides participants with knowledge for understanding the revised criteria of tanker ship vetting inspection based on the new edition SIRE 2.0 (January 2022) and the criteria of the vetting process with particular focus on the human factor. The new SIRE 2.0 process is explained in detail as well as the SIRE 2.0 three stage approach on *a) human factor b) audit and c) inspection*. The course also explains the strategies for managing the preparation of crew and vessel to pass a successful on-board SIRE 2.0 vetting inspection and avoid negative observations which may eventually have an impact on the vessel's quality service performance affecting commercially the vessel's commercial prospects
