

NAVIGATION SAFETY AUDITS & ASSESSMENTS

The course also makes extensive reference to the human factor, the skills, teamwork, and ongoing training required for effective and safe navigation with examples to be avoided leading to unsafe conditions and incidents

- Bridge teamwork and effective resource management
- Technical and behavioral seafarer skills affecting safety performance
- Emergency conditions and response
- Navigational audits and assessments
- Practical examples and workshops
