

RECRUITMENT & MANAGEMENT OF VESSEL PERSONNEL

Course aim and objectives: The course is based on maritime industry best practices included in OCIMF's TMSA 3, and IMO applicable standards confirming that the selection and recruitment process of seafarers is in line with requirements for ensuring seafarer proper certification, training, qualifications, competency standards, for serving on the right vessel and rank with focus on previous years of sea service and records. The course introduces techniques highlighting the need for accurate record review during the selection and recruitment process with emphasis on seafarer cultural diversity, seafarer motivation, seafarer achieved competency levels by rank for best results, high retention rates and continual improvement of the system

- Selection and recruitment concern issues
