

NAVIGATION ASSESSOR & AUDITOR

Course Aim & Objectives: The course enhances auditor skills for becoming qualified in conducting on-the-job dynamic navigation audits by learning new auditing techniques for determining bridge team performance and identifying potential performance gaps. The course combines audit and assessment methodologies for verifying key elements of technical bridge team skills combined with the assessment of behavioral bridge team competencies for proactive identification of gaps and training needs as well as improvement of the team's navigational skills, navigational safety performance and competency standards of the bridge team members. The course makes extensive reference to OCIMF's Best Practice Guidelines for performing Navigational Assessments & Audits

Course main elements:

- Organizing dynamic bridge team audits and assessments
- Setting audit and assessment objectives and standards
- Navigation Audit methods and techniques
- Navigation Auditor skills
- Conducting on the job dynamic navigational audit
- Assessments Vs Audits
- Auditor and Assessor integrated skills
- Measurement of bridge team competency performance
- Identification of potential gaps and training needs
- Development of integrated Navigational Audit & Assessment Reports
- Performance improvement planning
- Workshops, and final examination

Course Participation: The training is open to shipping company marine managers, fleet superintendents, internal auditors, bridge team senior members as well as office personnel responsible for conducting navigational audits and competency assessments for improving bridge team performance. Participants, for successful completion of the course and achieving a *certificate of completion as Navigation Assessor & Auditor*, are required to prepare and submit during the training a *navigational audit & assessment plan* for verification of performance standards of the vessel bridge team members. The course is integrated with the Marine Assessor training provided there is mixed background of seafarers - course participants i.e. Senior Deck Officers in attendance with Senior Engineer Officers
