INCIDENT INVESTIGATION & ROOT CAUSE ANALYSIS

Course aim and objectives: This course provides participants with the required knowledge for effective management of marine related risks affecting operational safety of vessels as a tool for identifying the necessary steps and controls to eliminate root cause(s) and other factors contributing to marine incidents. Proactive risk assessment process is an essential element for mitigating losses by preventing the occurrence of near misses and incidents and enhancing continual improvement of the safety management system. Course participants will also have the opportunity to go over various methodologies for tracing and identifying the causes during an incident investigation process with reference to maritime industry best practice guidance and IMO Model Course 3.11
