

ISM CODE - DESIGNATED PERSON ASHORE (DPA)

Course aim and objectives: The ISM Code requires shipping companies managing and operating ships to appoint a designated person ashore for effectively monitoring and maintaining the company's safety management system. The course provides participants with knowledge for being able to take over the DPA's responsibilities in compliance with the ISM Code and IMO MSC-MEPC.7/ Circ. 6 "Guidance on the qualification, training and experience necessary for taking over the role of the Designated Person under the provisions of ISM Code".

Course main elements:

- Understanding the ISM Code requirements
- Effective implementation and monitoring of the Safety Management System
- Mandatory rules and regulations
- DPA's authority and responsibility
- Verification and monitoring of safety and pollution prevention activities
- The link for communications between company's management and ships
- Safety management issues
- Practical workshops, case studies and final examination
