

## ISM CODE AWARENESS

**Course aim and objectives:** The ISM Code requires shipping companies managing and operating merchant ships to implement a safety management system. The ISM Code requirements are explained to course participants including the Code's risk control measures on safety and pollution prevention for reducing human error. The responsibilities under the ISM Code of shore personnel and crew members are also explained thoroughly

- Verification and certification requirements
