BEHAVIORAL BASED SAFETY AND COMPETENCY ASSESSMENTS

Course aim and objectives: Behavioral Based Safety (BBS) is an approach to safety focusing on seafarers' lack of behavioral competencies as a contributing factor, to most work-related injuries and accidents. Moreover, "at risk" behaviors are the least measurable and observable events before workplace injuries take place. Participants will have the opportunity to develop new skills through strategies for assessing Seafarer Behavioral Based Competencies and performance gaps in accordance with relevant regulations and industry standards through a systematic approach for motivating at work safer behavior by implementing a behavioral competency assurance management system involving shipboard assessment programs aligned with seafarer behavioral competencies. The course conforms with applicable regulatory framework, industry best practice guidance and relevant recommendations.

Course main elements:

- BBS principles, and structured patterns
- Contributing factors to work related injuries
- Determining decision, skill-based and perceptual errors
- Industry best practice guidance for ship operators
- Actions taken to reduce human error
- BBS process with applications
- Seafarer technical skills and behavioral competencies
- Behavioral competency assurance program(s)
- Implementing onboard behavioral competency assessment programs
- Seafarers' motivation and involvement in the process
- Analyzing and trending data demonstrating improvement of performance
