OCIMF TMSA 3 & SIRE VETTING INSPECTIONS

Course aim and objectives: Tanker ship operating companies establish and implement safety management systems according to the Elements of Tanker Management & Self-Assessment, in addition to ISM Code, for satisfying Major Oil Companies criteria and in parallel safeguarding commercial benefits and chartering advantages for their fleets. This course provides participants with the required knowledge for understanding and effectively implementing the requirements of TMSA 3 for enhancing safety culture, continual improvement, and promoting operational excellence. In addition, the course provides participants with knowledge for understanding the vetting process inspections combined with TMSA assessments and explains the strategies for preparing crew and vessel to pass a successful on-board SIRE Vetting inspection so as to avoid recurrence of high-risk observations which can eventually have an impact on the vessel's commercial and trading prospects and the overall profile of the company.
