SHIP ENVIRONMENTAL OFFICER

Course aim and objectives:

The course provides participants with the knowledge required to understand the duties and responsibilities of the ship's environmental officer who should have the experience and skills to supervise environmental protection issues related to the crew and ship operational matters. A ship's environmental officer is the role model responsible for ensuring compliance with the safety and environmental management system and promoting safety and environmental protection culture on board.

Course main elements:

- ISM Code pollution prevention requirements and workplace environment
- Duties and responsibilities of a ship's environmental officer
- Record keeping, hazard identification and assessment of risks
- Reporting requirements, operational issues and environmental inspections
- Environmental protection culture on board and training requirements
- Practical exercises, case studies and final examination

Course participation:

The course is open to shipping company safety, quality and environmental managers, superintendents, shipboard environmental officers and shipboard team members.

Course duration: 1 day
