

Train the Trainer and Maritime Assessor

Course aim and objectives:

This course provides the required knowledge for the training and assessment of maritime specialists, seafarers and onshore or offshore personnel according to STCW standards and the guidelines of IMO Model courses 6.09, 3.12 and 1.30 for maritime instructors and assessors. Course participants will become qualified in the process of organizing and instructing maritime training programs as well as performing on the job competence assessments by learning instructional, presentation, planning and assessment techniques required for enhancing the professional development of shipping company office staff, shipboard members or offshore specialist personnel.

Course main elements:

- Identifying training needs and setting learning objectives
- Planning and organizing maritime training programs
- Presentation, communication, assessment and evaluation techniques
- Performing on the job competence assessment
- Identifying knowledge, skills and abilities
- Performance measurement based on accepted standards
- Identifying performance gaps
- Effective guidance for improving performance
- Practical exercises, case studies and final examination

Course participation:

The course is open to maritime instructors and assessors, superintendents, and shipping or offshore company personnel with responsibilities for the training and professional development of office staff, seafarers and offshore specialist personnel.

Course duration: 4 days

This training program is currently provided in 24-hours with real time instruction through a dedicated e-platform in 6 four-hour pre-scheduled interactive web-based learning sessions.
