

Marine Internal Auditor of Integrated Management Systems

Course aim and objectives:

Shipping companies implement safety management systems integrated with elements of ISO international standards for conforming to the rapidly changing maritime industry requirements. This process provides the benefit of maintaining a corporate structured integrated management system enhancing continual improvement. The course provides the required knowledge for conducting integrated management system verification and qualifies participants as company internal auditors in accordance with established auditing principles for performing periodical internal audits of an integrated management system.

Course main elements:

- Internal audit requirements of the ISM Code, ISO 9001: 2015, ISO 14001: 2015, ISO 45001: 2018, ISO 50001:2018
- ISO 19001: 2018 guidelines for the internal audit process
- Marine Integrated Management Systems risk control dynamics
- Integrated Management Systems effective implementation
- Development of an effective integrated management system internal audit program
- Planning, conducting, reporting and following up on internal audits of an integrated management system
- Determining and handling of a non-conformity
- Practical exercises, case studies and final examination

Course participation:

The course is open to shipping company corporate quality managers, superintendents, internal auditors and office employees with responsibilities in the management system internal audit team. Prior knowledge of the ISM Code and of the relevant ISO international standards is required.

Course duration: 5 days

This training program is currently provided in 30-hours with real time instruction through a dedicated e-platform in 6 five-hour pre-scheduled interactive web-based learning sessions.
