

## TANKER SHIP SAFETY OFFICER

### Course aim and objectives:

The course provides participants with the knowledge required to understand the duties and responsibilities of the tanker ship's safety officer who should have the skills to ensure compliance with the safety management system, tanker and terminal industry guidelines, promote safety culture, assess behavioral based safety on board and follow up on vetting requirements.

### Course main elements:

- ISM Code safe practices in ship operations and workplace environment
- Duties and responsibilities of a tanker ship's safety officer
- Record keeping, hazard identification and assessment of risks
- Routine and non-routine operational matters
- Reporting requirements
- Tanker ship – terminal interaction and vetting inspections
- Safety culture, behavioral based safety and training requirements
- Practical exercises, case studies and final examination

### Course participation:

The course is open to tanker operating shipping company safety managers, safety superintendents, shipboard safety officers and shipboard safety team members

### Course duration: 1 day

This training program is currently provided in 6-hours with real time instruction through a dedicated e-platform in 2 three-hour pre-scheduled interactive web-based learning sessions
