

## LNG/LPG SHIP SAFETY OFFICER

### Course aim and objectives:

The course provides participants with the knowledge required to understand the duties and responsibilities of the LNG/LPG carrier safety officer who should have the skills to ensure compliance with the safety management system, LNG/LPG carrier and terminal industry guidelines, promote safety culture, assess behavioral based safety on board and follow up on vetting requirements.

### Course main elements:

- ISM Code safe practices in ship operations and workplace environment
- Duties and responsibilities of an LNG/LPG ship' s safety officer
- Record keeping, hazard identification and assessment of risks
- Routine and non-routine operational matters
- Reporting requirements
- LNG/LPG carrier – terminal interaction and vetting inspections
- Safety culture, behavioral based safety and training requirements
- Practical exercises, case studies and final examination

### Course participation:

The course is open to LNG/LPG carrier operating shipping company safety managers, safety superintendents, shipboard safety officers and shipboard safety team members

### Course duration: 1 day

This training program is currently provided in 6-hours with real time instruction through a dedicated e-platform in 2 three-hour pre-scheduled interactive web-based learning sessions
