

## Marine Internal Auditor - ISM Code

### Course aim and objectives:

The ISM Code is mandatory and requires shipping companies managing and operating ships to implement a safety management system for safe management and pollution prevention. This course provides the required knowledge for conducting management system verification and qualifies participants as company internal auditors in accordance with established auditing principles for performing periodical internal audits of a safety management system.

### Course main elements:

- ISM Code definitions and objectives
- ISM Code requirements for implementation of a Safety Management System
- Safety Management Systems risk control dynamics
- Safety Management Systems verification processes
- Development of an internal audit program
- Audit investigation techniques
- Determining and handling of a non-conformity
- Practical exercises, case studies and final examination

### Course participation:

The course is open to shipping company managers, superintendents and office employees with auditing responsibilities as well as ship crew members involved in the safety management system internal process

### Course duration: 2 days

This training program is currently provided in 12-hours with real time instruction through a dedicated e-platform in 3 four-hour pre-scheduled interactive web-based learning sessions
