

COMPANY SECURITY OFFICER – ISPS CODE MARITIME SECURITY REQUIREMENTS REFRESHER

Course aim and objectives:

The course provides participants with refresher knowledge to effectively implement the duties and responsibilities of the Company's security officer who should have the experience and skills to manage the fleet issues related to the crew and ship security operational matters. The company security officer is responsible for ensuring compliance of the fleet with the ship's security plan and review the plan as necessary to proactively organize effective response plans for ships passing through high risk areas confronted by security threats.

Course main elements:

- Overview of ISPS Code requirements and updates
- Ship security assessment and ship security plan implementation
- Duties and responsibilities of company security officer
- Record keeping, review, reporting and responding to risks and threats
- Security training and drills for crew members serving on fleet vessels
- Practical exercises, case studies and final examination

Course participation:

The course is open to shipping company security officers, security superintendents, Masters and shipboard team with designated security duties trained in security incident response.

Course duration: 1 day

This training program is currently provided in 6-hours with real time instruction through a dedicated e-platform in 2 three-hour pre-scheduled interactive web-based learning sessions.
