

## COMPLIANCE WITH MARITIME LABOUR CONVENTION (MLC 2006)

### Course aim and objectives:

This course provides shipping company operators with knowledge for complying with the requirements of the Maritime Labour Convention (MLC 2006) which was enforced in 2013. The Convention's main focus is on seafarers' rights but equally on the responsibilities of shipping companies and flag states. Emphasis is also placed on how companies should handle and resolve crew complaints and deficiencies for non-compliance.

### Course main elements:

- History and structure of the Convention
- Responsibilities and guidance according to MLC provisions
- Inspection and certification
- Resolution of deficiencies and crew complaint handling
- Amendments to the Convention
- Inspections by flag and port states
- Practical exercises and final examination

### Course participation:

The course is open to shipping company DPAs, Quality, HR, Crew and Training managers, superintendents with relevant responsibilities as well Masters and senior shipboard members.

### Course duration: 2 days

This training program is currently provided in 12-hours with real time instruction through a dedicated e-platform in 3 four-hour pre-scheduled interactive web-based learning sessions.
