

MARITIME LABOUR CONVENTION (MLC 2006)

INTERNAL AUDITOR

Course aim and objectives:

The Maritime Labour Convention (MLC 2006) provisions integrated in procedures in safety management systems require verification for compliance by means of internal audit. This course provides participants with the tools and practical knowledge for becoming qualified MLC internal auditors and sufficiently understand how to verify maritime labour related issues.

Course main elements:

- MLC 2006 compliance provisions
- Inspections and certification process
- Inspection and certification process
- Planning, conducting, reporting and following up on the audit process
- Handling of crew complaints and non-conformities
- Practical exercises and final examination

Course participation:

The course is open to shipping company DPAs, Quality, HR and Crew managers, superintendents with relevant responsibilities as well Masters and senior shipboard members.

Course duration: 2 days
